2. One original copy of transcripts or record of marks for each university-level school attended. Include English translation of each of any foreign documents. **Do not send transcripts of course work taken at Ohio State.** The Office of Graduate and Professional Admissions will obtain them directly from the Office of the University Registrar (at no cost to you) after your application arrives.
3. Official GRE or GMAT scores, TOEFL scores, if required. Send to institution code 1592 only.
